White Sail I, II, and III

This 2-week program is designed for beginner sailors aged 10-16 years old, and uses our fleet of 420 dinghys. The program stresses on-water skills and classroom segments on skills such as knots and terminology while working towards CYA White Sail Levels I, II, and III. These levels cover the basic skills of sailing, including safety, seamanship, and boat handling in wind strengths up to 9 knots.

Bronze IV and V



This 4-week program is designed to challenge and refine the basic skills learned in the White Sail program. Introducing performance sailing, this program is designed to achieve the CYA Bronze Sail standards and includes sail trim, advanced sailing theory, boat tuning, boat maintenance, use of spinnaker and trapeze, and an introduction to racing.

This 8-week program is designed for the advanced sailor and builds on the skills learned in the Bronze Sail program. The course has a strong racing emphasis, and attendance at out-of-town regattas is a required part of the program.

An informal warmup program, included as part of registration, starts before the regular session.

Registrants are required to have their own Lasers or Bytes. Boat owners should also note that some racing equipment upgrades may be required.

MOSQUITO SAILING CAMP

This is a 1-week discovery program for children aged 7-9 organized so you can register for as many weeks as desired. The program uses our fleet of Mosquito dinghies, designed and built specially for this age group. The program combines a fun on-the-water and on-land activities in a safe and group-oriented setting while working towards White Sail Levels I and II.

Access Sailing

This program is designed for children with cognitive or physical disabilities, ages 8 and up. It provides participants with a fun and safe opportunity to learn how to sail. The students sail in dinghies which have a weighted centerboard/keel so they will not capsize, comfortable forward facing hammock style seating, joystick steering, and a roller furling sail.
